Time Out tells you why the word "dessert" is no longer restricted to bundles of sweetness



Mac and cheese jar If you need something to carelessly dig into while watching a romcom in your pyjamas, then call for this sinful treat in a jar from Country of Origin. Modelled on the lines of COO's famous dessert jars, this savoury cousin is also a layered preparation. At the bottom of the jar (which is smaller than the sweet one), is a base of torn Cheddar muffins. On top, perches a layer of macaroni and cheese flavoured with smoked paprika, with a spicy aftertaste. The dish is finished with a film of puffed pastry a la purdah biryani, a surprisingly crispy touch that contrasts with the otherwise gooey preparation. Team it with crackers for best results.
